


Study Abroad Trip 2025 Quebec, Montreal, Ottawa Canada April 19 – 25, 2025





COA Study Abroad 2025

- College of The Albemarle (COA) students will gain global experience by participating in any of the college's study abroad trips. Dual-enrolled students are eligible if they will be 16 years old by the time of the trip. While students have the first right to participate, any available spots are open to faculty, staff and community members.



Mont-Royal is a large hill located in the middle of Montreal. At 234 meters, Mount Royal is the highest point in Montreal. It is affectionately called The Mountain by Montreal locals. Montreal is named after this 761 foot hill, which also houses the famous Mount-Royal Park (Parc du Mont-Royal), one of Montreal's largest green spaces. From the top of Mount-Royal, you will get some impressive views of downtown Montreal and the surrounding area.

- Round-trip transportation

- Total Fee:* \$2,663.00
- Tour Quote Breakdown
- The following fees apply to your full-paying participants:
 - Tour Fee: \$2,357.00
 - On Tour Tipping: \$27.00
 - Travel Protection Plus: \$279.00 (Cannot be financed, see next slide)
 - = Total Tour Fee: \$2,663.00
- OR 10 Monthly Payments of \$233.40 after initial payment of \$50.00

TOUR FEES (Cont.)

- Required Travel Protection Plan Plus
- The cost for the Travel Protection Plan Plus for this Canada tour will be \$279. It's no longer automatically added to the total tour fee on your Tour Center website; however, it's the only option available to travelers that are enrolling onto our tour, so you *must* select it. Below is a screenshot of what you'll see:

WHY YOU NEED TRAVEL PROTECTION

Explorica strongly recommends you purchase one of our comprehensive travel protection plans. With our plans, you're covered in case you lose your bags, misplace your tickets or passport, or get sick or injured during the tour. Don't miss this chance to protect your tour investment, your belongings - and most importantly, yourself.

Ten Day "Free Look" – If you are not satisfied for any reason, you may cancel your travel protection insurance within ten (10) days from the date of purchase by providing us a written cancellation notice. After the 10 Day "Free Look" period expires, the purchase of your travel protection insurance is non-refundable.

The below total price of travel protection plans is estimated and will be calculated based on your total price at enrollment. The final price may change depending on additional upgrades or add-ons selected on the following pages.

O Travel Protection Plan Plus (\$379.00)

Along with providing you the same benefits as our standard Travel Protection Plan (see below), the Explorica Travel Protection Plan Plus also includes our exclusive Cancel For Any Reason Waiver Benefit.

With your Cancel For Any Reason Waiver Benefit, if you cancel your trip for any reason not otherwise covered by this policy, we will reimburse you for 75% of the non-refundable cancellation fees which apply to your trip, provided:

- 1. Payment for this plan is received by Explorica within 14 days of your initial deposit/payment for your trip; and
- 2. You cancel your trip 48 hours (2 days) or more before your scheduled trip departure date

This Cancel For Any Reason Waiver Benefit does not cover: 1) penalties associated with any air or other travel arrangements not provided by Explorica; or 2) the failure of Explorica to provide the bargained-for travel arrangements due to cessation of operations for any reason.

The Cancel For Any Reason Waiver Benefit is provided by Explorica and is not an insurance benefit underwritten by United States Fire Insurance Company and must be purchased within 14 days of your initial payment for your trip.

Travel Protection Plan (\$158.00)

Our standard travel protection plan covers you for the following events:

- 1. A traveler's injury, sickness, or death of a family member
- 2. Theft of passport or visas
- 3. Flight cancellations due to strike or bad weather
- 4. Loss of luggage and personal effects
- 5. Trip cancellation or trip interruption due to covered reasons such as a covered sickness, illness, injury, or death
- 6. Trip cancellation or trip interruption due to terrorist acts

Required Travel Protection Plan Plus

- The cost of the Travel Protection Plan Plus must be paid in full at the time of enrollment, so it doesn't affect the monthly payment amounts, which is approximately \$234.00/month for 10 months after the \$50 deposit.
- There is a 2% processing fee now for credit card payments, so if you pay by CC then the overall amount they've paid will be higher than that. You can pay by checking account to avoid that processing fee.

- Adult Supplement \$45.00
- Twin Room Upgrade \$270.00
- Additional Adult Fee \$315.00

- College of The Albemarle (COA) is proud to be a member institution of the North Carolina Scholar of Global Distinction Program (NCSGDP). A broad knowledge of other countries and cultures is important for citizens in today's global community. In addition, employers increasingly seek globally competent/aware employees. COA values cultural diversity and supports "an emphasis on teaching about global issues and world regions to prepare students to work in a global economy and live in an interconnected world."
- NCSGDP participants who successfully complete the program receive "Graduated with Global Distinction" on their transcripts, an honors graduation stole, and a joint certificate from COA and World View from the University of North Carolina - Chapel Hill recognizing this accomplishment. This honor can be listed on resumes or university applications.



Scholar of Global Distinction Requirements

- To successfully complete the NCSGDP, students will meet the following requirements:
 - Complete at least <u>15 credit hours of globally intensive courses</u>
 - Participate in eight international activities and dialogue
 - Gain global experience (<u>30 hours of participation in either study abroad</u>, approved personal international travel, or a domestic intercultural experience)
 - Give a capstone presentation and write a reflection paper on your experiences in the program.
